
Lavender Flower Painting

Provided in the kits:

- Acrylic paint (light purple, dark purple, green, white, and black)
- Paint brush
- 5x7 Canvas
- Wooden dowel
- Cotton swabs

Instructions:

- 1. Dab drops of white paint across the canvas.
- 2. Dab a VERY SMALL amount of black paint onto the canvas focusing on the outer edges.
- 3. Using the paint brush, brush long vertical strokes across the canvas to blend the colors.
- 4. Add small amounts of black or white until you are happy with the shading.
- 5. Allow to dry completely.
- 6. Add green paint to the plate.
- 7. Using a clean paint brush, brush green paint onto the wooden dowel.
- 8. Press the skewer onto the canvas to create a stem.
- 9. Continue this process approximately 10 times across the canvas.
 - Add white paint to the green to add a variety of stem shades.
 - Use the brush to create thicker or varying stem shapes.
- 10. Allow to dry completely.
- 11. Add light purple paint to the plate.
- 12. Using a cotton swab and paint, begin to dot around some of the stems to form petals.
 - Keep in mind that lavender tends to have a cone shape pointy at the top and fuller and rounder along the bottom.
- 13. Allow to dry completely.
- 14. Add dark purple paint to the plate.
- 15. Using a cotton swab, begin to dot the darker paint on top of and around the lighter dots.
- 16. Add white paint to the purple to add a variety of petal shades.
- 17. Allow to dry completely before displaying.
