Make IT AT home Book Page Roses

Provided in the kits:

- Book pages
- Cloth stem wire (5)
- Lollipop stick

You will also need:

- Scissors
- Glue (hot or tacky glue will work best)
- Ruler

Instructions:

Create sets of petals:

- 1. 1Fold the corner of a book page to create a large triangle.
 - Trim to remove the "overhanging" paper.
- 2. Open the page to reveal a square (approximately 5.5 inches x 5.5 inches).
- 3. Fold the square in half 3 times, creating a smaller triangle each time.
- 4. Place the triangle with the "open" edge facing up.
- 5. Lay the petal template in the fully "closed" corner and cut around.
 - There should be 8 petals when the flower is unfolded.
- 6. Repeat steps (1-5) for a total of 4 flower templates.
- 7. Take one template and cut off 1 petal (creating 1 petal and 7 petals).
- 8. Take a second template and cut off a set of 2 petals (creating 2 petals and 6 petals).
- 9. Take a third template and cut off a set of 3 petals (creating 3 petals and 5 petals).
- 10. Take the fourth template and cut it in half (creating 4 petals x2) only 1 set of 4 is needed.
 - You should now have 7 separate pieces.

Assemble the rose:

- 1. For each piece, glue the first and last petal together creating a small funnel.
 - Re-crease the petal folds for a more defined look.
- 2. Use the lollipop stick to curl the tips of the petals outward.
- Put glue inside the largest set of petals and place the second largest on top.
- 4. Continue with progressively smaller petals, alternating the location of the petals when gluing.
- 5. Glue a stem in the bottom center of each flower.
 - Trim stems if desired
- 6. Repeat all steps to create a bouquet of 4-5 flowers.
- 7. Allow to dry completely before displaying.
