Make IT AT home

Home Gweet Home Bookstack

Provided in the kits:

- 3 hardback books
- White acrylic paint
- Paint brush
- Jute twine
- "Home Sweet Home" vinyl transfer



You will also need:

- Scissors
- A library card or other straight edge (to help transfer your vinyl)
- Paper to cover your workspace
- 1. Lay the books flat on the table with the spines facing you. Determine which order you would like your books to be stacked.
- 2. Paint the top and spine of each book.
 - Allow to dry completely.
 - You may need 2-3 coats for full coverage.
- 3. Run the edge of your library card firmly over each vinyl transfer to ensure the lettering is securely in place.
- 4. Slowly peel the *paper* backing from one of the transfers, making sure the vinyl lettering stays on the clear transfer paper.
 - Place the word approximately 1/2 inch from the end of the book, and apply the clear transfer paper and vinyl lettering to the spine.
 - Press down firmly to adhere the vinyl lettering to the book.
 - Run the edge of your library card firmly over the clear transfer paper to ensure the vinyl lettering is securely adhered to the book.
 - Slowly peel the *clear transfer paper* off, leaving the wording behind.
- 5. Repeat Step 4 for the other two books and vinyl transfers.
- 6. Stack the books in order and display on a table or shelf.

Optional: Use the provided jute twine or ribbon of your choice to tie the books into a stack. Add embellishments such as flowers or seasonal décor if desired.
