Make IT AT home Tissue Paper Watercolor

Provided in the kits:

Bleeding tissue paper Canvas board 2 printable quotes Black permanent marker Sponge

You will also need:

Pencil Water A covered workspace – to avoid stains



- 1. Select a printable quote for your project.
- 2. On the backside of the printable, completely color over the design with a pencil.
- 3. Flip the paper over and position the quote on your canvas.
- 4. Take a sharp pencil and trace over the outline of the letters.
- 5. Remove the paper from the canvas to reveal the transferred quote.
- 6. Use a permanent marker to fill in the lettering on your canvas.
- 7. Allow the permanent marker to dry.
- 8. Lightly wet your canvas with a sponge and water.
- 9. Lay the tissue squares onto the wet canvas in a design of your choice you may need to again wet the area until the tissue is completed saturated.
- 10. For a vibrant color, allow the tissue squares to dry for a minimum of 5 minutes. For a pastel color, remove the tissue squares sooner.
- 11. Repeat the tissue process again if you desire a more "layered" look.
