

# make IT AT home *Hexagon Shelf*

## **Provided in the kits:**

- Popsicle sticks (approx. 100)
- Brown stain/paint
- Paintbrush
- Hexagon shelf template

## **You will also need:**

- Glue (tacky works best)
- Paper to cover your workspace
- Paper towel
- Picture hanger or nails (optional)



1. Lay three popsicle sticks on the template, covering every other side.
2. Add a drop of glue to both ends of the three popsicle sticks.
3. Layer three more sticks to complete the hexagon.
4. Continue gluing and layering until your hexagon shelf is as deep as you'd like it to be. (The sample photo is 15 layers deep).
5. Allow the glue to dry completely.
6. Use the brown paint to "stain" the shelf - making sure to get between all of the sticks.
  - Tip: for a lighter stain, wipe surface with a paper towel after painting.
7. Allow to dry completely.
8. Options:
  - A picture hanger or nails can be used to display the shelf on the wall
  - The shelf could also be displayed on a table or bookshelf.
