Beaded Wind Chime

Provided in the kits:

- Waxed string (5, 12-inch pieces)
- Beads (approximately 175)
- 5 miniature bells
- 1 piece of driftwood (with 5 pre-drilled holes)
- 1 beading needle
- Baker's twine (16 inches)

You will also need:

- Scissors
- Ruler – if desired



Instructions:

1. Feed a piece of waxed string through a bell and tie a knot.
2. Using the beading needle, thread approx. 30-35 beads onto the string.
 - The needle is bendable and pulls apart to create an "eye".
3. Feed the string through one of the pre-drilled holes in the drift wood.
4. Wrap the string once around the drift wood and knot.
5. Repeat steps 1-4 for all 5 pieces of string.
 - If you would like your wind chime to have various lengths of thread, trim as desired before adding the beads and bells.
6. Using the beading needle, feed the baker's twine through the first pre-drilled hole.
7. Tie a knot to hold the twine in place.
8. Leaving enough slack to create a hanger (approx. 8 inches), feed the baker's twine through the last pre-drilled hole.
9. Tie a knot to hold the twine in place.
10. Trim off the excess twine.
