Adult books, children's books, art reproductions, audiobooks, DVDs, CDs, and other miscellaneous items will all be sold during the event. Items sold at the sale are provided by the library and by local donations.

Buyers will be able to find the most recent best sellers and the latest CDs and DVDs - all priced under \$2.00.


