Easter Egg Bunny

Provided in the kits:

- 2 plastic Easter eggs
- 2 bows
- Bunny ear template
- Jute twine
- Pink felt
- Tan felt
- Small, black cardstock circles
- White plastic lacing cord

You will also need:

- Hot glue
- Scissors
- Pen



Instructions:

1. Place a drop of glue at the top point of the egg.
2. Press one end of the twine into the glue. Begin wrapping the twine around the egg, periodically adding glue to keep the twine in place.
3. Stop adding twine once you have a small circle of egg still exposed on the bottom.
4. Cut the twine and glue the end in place.
 - With the ledge created at the bottom, the egg should stand upright.
5. Using the bunny ear template and tan felt, trace and cut out two ears.
6. Using the pink felt, cut out two small, elongated ovals for the inner part of the ears.
7. Glue the pink felt pieces to the center of the tan felt pieces.
8. Place a drop of glue at the base of each ear and adhere to the top of the egg.
9. Cut a small, rounded triangle from the pink felt.
10. Trim small pieces of white plastic cord and glue to the nose as whiskers.
11. Glue the nose - whisker side down - to the center of the bunny's face.
12. Glue two small black cardstock circles as eyes.
13. Glue a bow in front of the ears.
14. Allow to dry completely before displaying.
