Pinwheel Wreath

Provided in the kits:

- 4×4" inch squares of double-sided scrapbook paper (16)
- Small buttons (16)
- Cardboard wreath form
- White paint
- Sponge

You will also need:

- Glue – hot glue will work best
- Scissors
- Paper to cover your workspace



1. Paint the wreath form white and allow to dry completely.
2. For each of the 16 square papers:
 - Fold corner to corner, creating a triangle.
 - Unfold.
 - Fold the opposite corners together creating another triangle.
 - Unfold to reveal the x created. These are the lines you'll use to cut and fold your pinwheel.
 - Cut along each line, stopping approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ inch from the center.
3. Create 16 pinwheels:
 - Place a drop of hot glue on one corner. Fold down and secure in the center.
 - Continue this process, folding down every other corner.
 - Glue a button to the center of each pinwheel and allow to dry completely.
4. Glue the pinwheels to the wreath form.
 - Layer and tuck the pinwheels close together for a fuller look.
