Mini Button Flower Bouquet

Provided in the kits:

- Book pages
- Scrapbook paper
- Flower template (2 sizes)
- Assorted Buttons
- Wire (5 pre-cut pieces)
- Ribbon
- Small glass jar
- Small gems

You will also need:

- Scissors
- Pencil



1. Using the ribbon, tie a bow around the neck of the jar – trim as needed.
2. Fill the glass jar with small gems and set aside.
3. Using the small flower template and book pages, trace and cut out a flower.
4. Using the larger flower template and scrapbook pages, trace and cut out another flower.
5. Place the small flower on top of the larger flower.
6. Take one piece of wire and poke a hole in the center of the stacked flowers.
7. Thread a button on top of the flowers.
8. Push the flowers and buttons to the middle of your wire.
9. Bend the wire in half.
10. Thread the end of the wire through another button hole and poke a second hole through the paper flower.
11. Pull the wire tight, being careful not to rip the flower.
12. Twist the ends of the wire around each other to create a stem.
13. Repeat steps 1-9 to create 4 or 5 more flowers for your bouquet.
14. Twist all 5 stems together at the bottom to create a secure bouquet.
15. Poke your flower stems into the gems and arrange flowers as needed.
