## Mini Button Flower Bouquet

## Provided in the kits:

- Book pages
- Scrapbook paper
- Flower template (2 sizes)
- Assorted Buttons
- Wire (5 pre-cut pieces)
- Ribbon
- Small glass jar
- Small gems

## You will also need:

- Scissors
- Pencil
- 1. Using the ribbon, tie a bow around the neck of the jar trim as needed.
- 2. Fill the glass jar with small gems and set aside.
- 3. Using the small flower template and book pages, trace and cut out a flower.
- 4. Using the larger flower template and scrapbook pages, trace and cut out another flower.
- 5. Place the small flower on top of the larger flower.
- 6. Take one piece of wire and poke a hole in the center of the stacked flowers.
- 7. Thread a button on top of the flowers.
- 8. Push the flowers and buttons to the middle of your wire.
- 9. Bend the wire in half.
- 10. Thread the end of the wire through another button hole and poke a second hole through the paper flower.
- 11. Pull the wire tight, being careful not to rip the flower.
- 12. Twist the ends of the wire around each other to create a stem.
- 13. Repeat steps 1-9 to created 4 or 5 more flowers for your bouquet.
- 14. Twist all 5 stems together at the bottom to create a secure bouquet.
- 15. Poke your flower stems into the gems and arrange flowers as needed.
